

# Sunday in the Round

**Sundays** It is helpful as Christians to see Sunday as a whole day and not just a day when we may attend one or two meetings.

It is a day given to us for our community worship, fellowship, hospitality and equipping us to be disciples of Christ. In our busy lives Sundays are to be seen in the context of the whole of our lives – a chosen use of our time for God's glory and purposes. This year we are exploring the theme of "Building, Outreach and Belonging".

**Sunday at 10.30am** is our main service. It includes a crèche and children's groups.

In order to take account of modern life styles, the need to prepare for the working week, the need to rest and to enable families and individuals to have time together we are planning sessions after the morning service.

**First Sunday in the month** The Lord's Supper is held from 6.30pm to 7.30pm and is followed by refreshments. This gives continuity and security to some in our fellowship. Prayer ministry for healing will be offered for all who ask.



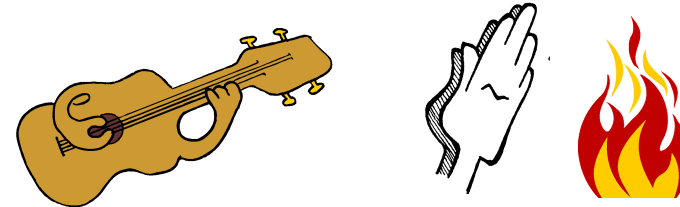
# Worship & Discipleship

## Second Sunday in the Month is Hospitality

**Sunday** This is a challenge to invite others to lunch spend time getting to know one another. Lunch may be in a home, a café or a restaurant, or the church hall. Lunch could be with people in the fellowship, family, friends or neighbours.

**Third Sunday in the month** is for Discipleship and follows the morning service. We are invited to bring a packed lunch and at about 12.30pm various teaching sessions or workshops will be held

**Fourth Sunday in the Month is Flame Prayer** It is organised by two Deacons with music of keyboard or guitar. This follows the morning service at 12.30pm and everyone is invited to bring a packed lunch and join in. This will last generally until 2.00pm. There will be activities for children



**Fifth Sunday in the month** there is a Vision Building Day four times a year, when food is provided on the basis of "bring and share" and everyone is invited to contribute to developing the life and work of the church.
